

spiramycin ¹³ Provamicina Rovamicina	ANTIPROTOZOAL, AntiCryptosporidiosis, AntiToxoplasmosis (not FDA approved) Oral, rectal suppository & Parenteral (IV) Drug: Take oral form on empty stomach. Food ↓ bioavailability 50%. ¹³ Oral/GI: N/V, stomach pain, diarrhea. Rare ulcerated esophagitis, acute colitis. S/Cond: Caution with hepatic impairment. Pregnancy: Safe in pregnancy. ¹³ Other: Allergic reaction, rash, itching. Rare cardiac toxicity, cholestatic hepatitis. Blood/Serum: ↓ platelets. Rare ↑ SGPT, alk phos. Monitor: Possibly hepatic func.
Sporanox	ANTIFUNGAL, ANTI-CANDIDIASIS See itraconazole p 65
stavudine (d4T) Zerit Bristol-Myers Squibb Cap-- lactose, starch	ANTIRETROVIRAL, NRTI Drug: Take without regard to meals. Nutr: Anorexia, ↓ wt. Oral/GI: Stomatitis, N/V, abdominal pain, <u>diarrhea</u> . S/Cond: Limit alcohol. Not with lactation. Pregnancy: Category C. Other: <u>PERIPHERAL NEUROPATHY</u> , <u>chills/fever</u> , headache, weakness, muscle pain, dementia, insomnia, rash, pancreatitis (can be fatal). Blood/Serum: <u>SGOT</u> , <u>SGPT</u> , alk phos, bil, <u>amylase</u> , lipase, anemia, ↓platelets, ↓ <u>neutrophils</u> . Monitor: Hepatic func, amylase, lipase.
